

Let's Protect Ourselves When Using the Internet


















Haha! I've got many friend requests today!

Maybe because I'm likable and other people say good things about me. So people want to be my friend. If there is a stranger on the street asking you to be your friend, would you be friend with him/her?






No way, mom!

...or click on a link to advertisements, photos or videos because we never know what would happen! Sometimes, it contains viruses or can steal information from your phone too!






Really? But my friends don't seem to have any problem. I saw them sharing their friends' photo. It looks fun, mom!

If there is someone asking to meet you or asking you to send photo or video of yourself, please let mom and dad know immediately!






Your dad is right! Let's wash your hands and eat! I will let you know more!
